the freedom to pursue your own desires while sharing your experiences with the other person

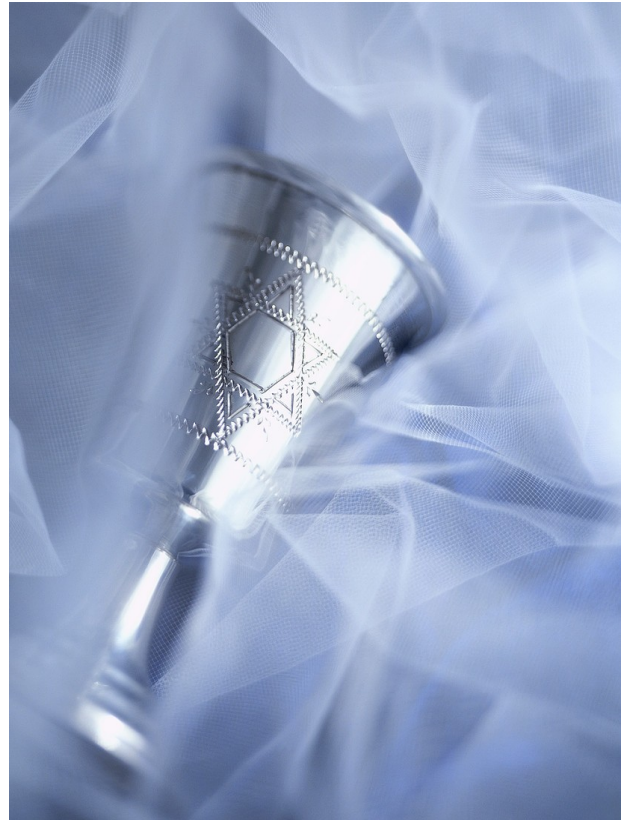
